BKC Member Show Results

Amy Nelson reports that she and her two Miniature Australian Shepherd puppies attended an ISABCA International Conformation Dog show in Hutchinson, MN on May 15 and 16th. **Libby** qualified both a National and International Puppy Title, and **Dyson** qualified for a National Puppy Title, both in the 3-6 month category. Also, another pup from that litter, **Aggie**, owned by **Kari Dayton**, also earned her National Puppy Title.

Susan Voss and **Katie** competed at the Key City show in St. Peter in Open A class and earned their first leg towards CDX title with a 193 for second place.

Open competition is much tougher than any previous competitions they've entered. On Sunday, there were 15 dogs competing in Open A and only 5 qualified.

Carol Manley and **Rumble** competed in the Novice B class at the Fargo-Moorhead Kennel Club in April. Rumble qualified on Saturday with a 195, picked up his first leg and won the class.

Carol also showed **Rumble** at the Bernese Mtn. Dog National Specialty in May. They competed in the Novice B class, qualifying again with a 195 & picking up their 2nd leg.

Deb Leimbek and her Labrador Retriever, **Lacey** took Best of Breed at the Key City Kennel Club Dog show Memorial Day weekend. She received 2 points towards her championship with this win.

Kim Schwendeman and her Doberman, **Raya** have been busy at agility trials. On May 1 & 2 they competed in St. Cloud at the Canine Agility of Central MN USDAA trial and qualified

in Starters Snooker with a perfect score of 51 and 1st place. They also qualified in Starters Gamblers, finishing that title (**SG**) and finished the Starters Pairs Relay title (**SR**) with a 3rd place. They qualified in Starters Jumpers and Starters Standard with 1st and 3rd placings in the 26" jump height division. At the Minnesota Agility Club trial in Lake Elmo on May 29th and 30th, they received qualifying scores in Starters Jumpers completing that title (**SG**) and Starters Standard (**SSA**) with 2nd and 1st placements. They also qualified in Starters Snooker with a score of 46. Raya also received her **AD** title (Agility Dog) at this trial.

Dianna Anderson and the Beadie Boys have been to some USDAA (United States Dog Agility Association) Trials. USDAA is the world's largest independent authority for the sport of dog agility, with more than 25,000 registered competitors and more than 200 different breeds of dogs, including mix breeds. The lowest level (Starters) classes in this organization compare to an Open level class at an AKC trial. At the May 1-2 Canine Agility of Central MN trial, **Logan** finished his Starters Pairs Relay title (**SR**) with a 1st place. Starters Relay is a class in which the course is separated into 2 halves. You and a partner decide which half of the course you will run. After the 1st half is run, then that handler passes a baton to the second team, who finishes the course. It's alot of fun. At the Minnesota Agility Club Trial, Memorial Day Weekend, Logan finished his Starters Snooker Title (**SS**) with a 2nd place, and **River**, who made his USDAA

debut that weekend, received a leg in Starters Jumpers with a 2nd place.

At the St. Paul Dog Training Club AKC agility trial, April 10 and 11, **River** competed in Novice B. He received a leg in Novice B Standard with a 2nd place, and received 2 legs in Novice B Jumpers with Weaves with a 2nd and 3rd place.

Jaci Pederson and **Nestle** got their Utility title (**UD**), May 16th in Lacrosse! They did it in 4 trys, with a 198 1/2 in Fargo, 192 & 198 in LaCrosse!

Roger Pederson and **Kihei** won **High in Trial** and **High Combined** both days in Fargo and another **High in Trial** in LaCrosse.

Janet Hennes and **Miko** completed her first title in USDAA **P1 Jumpers**. They are hoping to pick up a few more this summer!

Sally Ihne's Shetland Sheepdog, **Ernie**, earned his first leg toward his CDX degree at the Minneapolis Kennel Club's Obedience Trial on February 28, 2010 with a score of 194.5 in Open A.

At the Key City Kennel Club Show on Sunday, May 30, **Ernie** also won his third leg toward his Companion Dog Excellent title, but he still hasn't earned the title since he needs to qualify under a third judge. (Right now two of his qualifying legs are under one judge.) He won the Open A class with a score of 194.

Ernie finished his **CDX** on June 12th at the Lake Minnetonka Kennel Club with a score of 194.5 under Cynthia Rustad. He placed second. The next day he added a bonus with a score of 190.5 under Mary Higdem and placed third.

Donna Niggeler and her Labrador **Jadah** have been to many agility trials.

At the March 27th/28th Isanti CPE (Canine Performance Event) trial, she received legs and 1st places in Level 4 Standard, Level 3 Jumpers, and Level 3 Wildcard to receive her **CL3-H** title.

At the April 10-11th CPE trial in Cannon Falls, **Jadah** received qualifying legs and 1st places in Level 4 Standard, and Level 3 Jumpers, to give them their **CL3-F** title. Then in level 4 Snooker they also got a 1st place. They also got qualifying legs and 2nd placements in Level 4 Wildcard, and Level 4 Colors.

Then they attended the St. Cloud USDAA agility trial on May 1st, and **Jadah** received a qualifying leg and 1st place in Performance 3 Pairs.

The next trial they went to was the May 15-16 CPE trial in Cannon Falls. They received qualifying scores and 1st places in Level 4 Jumpers and Level 4 Snooker, as well as Level 4 Full house and Level 4 Colors. At the same trial they received qualifying legs and 2nd place in Level 4 Wildcard, Jackpot, and Standard, which gave her the **CL4-R** title.

Finally, they attended the Lake Elmo USDAA agility trial on May 29th, where she took home a qualifying leg and 1st place in Performance 3 Jumpers, and 2nd in Performance 3 pairs.

Donna also reports that **Spot**, her Border Collie passed the **CGC** & is currently in training!

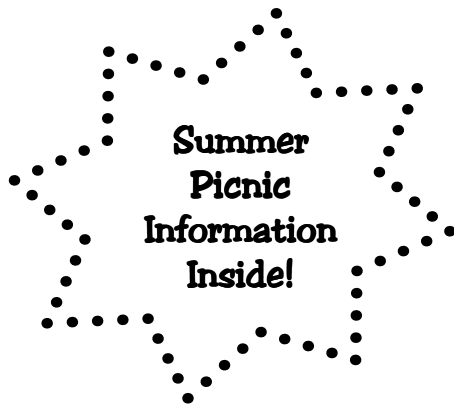
